SPRED is our Special Religious Education Group for our parishioners with special needs and meets in twenty-one groups around our Diocese, as well as in our local special needs schools, through 200 volunteer parishioners. Last year your Advent Boxes brought in an amazing £12,000.00. We will be holding our annual SPRED Parish collection in February which, last year, raised £23,000.00. Thanks again for your generosity which is helping this wonderful organisation in our Diocese to spread and grow from strength to strength. Along with our *Friends Fundraising Campaign* and our annual collection our Advent Boxes pay for just over 50% of this ministry.
